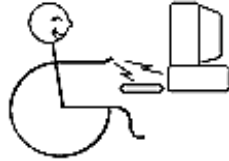

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iPad Ultimate Case

Installation

- 1) Remove keyrings.
- 2) Pull off 'wings'.
- 3) Pull apart the 2 halves.
- 4) Remove inner 'bladder'.
- 5) Insert iPad.
- 6) Re-assemble.

iPad 2 Only

This case was originally designed for the iPad 1. When the iPad 2 came out, the case that the manufacturer designed was not appropriate for our special needs. So I was forced to adapt the original for use with the iPad 2. I can find no other case on the market that is 'rugged' and allows for a shoulder strap. I've tried them all, from the Otterbox to The Kraken.

You will easily see my modifications. Hopefully, you can live with how they *look*. As far as *functionality*, I believe I'm right 'on the money'.

The dock connector is still fully accessible.

We have large holes in the case for the rear facing camera, so even if the iPad 2 slides around a bit inside the case, the camera can still 'see'.

Truly, if there were a better alternative out there, I would pursue it. But this is still the best rugged case available that lends itself to our shoulder strap.

So give this case a try.

If not, contact me and I'll give you an RMA to return it, and either let me send you an Otterbox Defender, or I can refund your purchase price. I try as hard as I can to get you the best things possible.
